Measles can be dangerous, especially for children. Protect your child with a measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine.

**There is a measles outbreak in Minneapolis. If you are traveling or having visitors, make sure your child is vaccinated.*

Call your doctor or Columbus Public Health at (614) 645-1474 if you have symptoms – and stay home and avoid having visitors until you see a doctor.
