Zika Virus Preconception Counseling & Prevention of Sexual Transmission

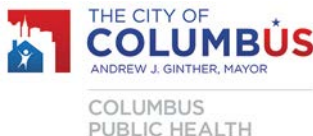

Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) has updated guidance for healthcare providers related to Zika virus preconception counseling and prevention of sexual transmission. CDC has updated recommendations to help healthcare providers discuss pregnancy planning with women and their partners, including suggested time frames for waiting to get pregnant after possible exposure to Zika virus.
